- 3. Compare the attitudes of the Thai monks about condom distribution and safe sex education with the attitudes of the African-American clergy profiled in the other RELIGION & ETHICS NEWSWEEKLY segments you have seen.
- 4. From reading the transcript, would you say that people with AIDS are well-tolerated and accepted in Thailand? Explain.
